



When traveling South to Camp Lindblad, the shortest distance from the Council Service Center is to go South on 680 which turns into 280. Then turn South on Saratoga Avenue off from 280. This will turn into Highway 9. Then continue traveling South for 22 miles on a very windy and curvy 2 lane road. Passengers usually will get car sick.

You may want to try 680 to 280 and turn South on Highway 17 to Scott's Valley. Turn right on Mt. Herman Road which dead ends into Highway 9 in Felton. Turn right (North) on Highway 9 and go through Ben Lomond and then Boulder Creek and turn right on Kings Creek Road. Traveling this way you will not see the Mountain Store/Gas. This is the fastest and has the most Freeway driving. There is a lot less car sickness.

Bear Creek Road is just as curvy as Highway 9. There are several single lane strips of roadway that have washed away during the winter storms.
